- Provide a list of Works Cited

Project Choices

- 1. <u>Make a Video / Ted Talk</u> you can make a documentary, a commercial, or do a Newscast.
- 2. <u>Create a Newspaper</u> Make your information into a single article or a whole front page (be sure to include images!)
- 3. <u>Deliver a Speech</u> "Get on your soapbox" and speak to the class about your topic. You should include some images to show us.
- 4. <u>Make a Poster</u>- Use a combination of images and text to deliver your information!
