## Service Learning Project 1 point\* (\*can earn multiple times)

• Complete a minimum of 25 hours of demonstrated service to the community

Service learning is an inquiry-based approach that combines service to community with learning objectives. The most meaningful service-learning projects are personally relevant to students and their interests. Students can complete service learning projects individually, or with a small group or as part of a larger group. Students generally experience service learning with the leadership of an adult. Service learning projects are most effective when connected to the curriculum and the key indicator is that the service performed is connected to a community-based problem or need.

Service learning is generally described in five stages:

- 1. Investigation conduct research on a community-based problem or needs
- 2. Preparation create a plan to address these needs
- 3. Action
- 4. Evidence submission
- 5. Reflection required to earn the point for the Diploma Seal
- 6. Demonstration/celebration

<u>For Example</u>: Conduct some research or participate in a class lesson on "Community Engagement in Central New York and the Cincinnatus Community"
