Key Points:

- In order to earn the .5 points a student must earn the score of "Satisfactory" in every rubric category.
- If a student scores "Developing/Incomplete" in any rubric category, comments will be provided as to how the student can improve their score.
- After receiving their initial score and comments, a student can resubmit their Elective Course Student Review and Reflection <u>one</u> additional time.
- A student is always more than welcome to meet with members of the Seal of Civic Readiness Committee (SCRC) to discuss their score and comments prior to the resubmission of their work.
- If a student is found plagiarizing their work in any way they will not receive the Seal of Civic Readiness credit and will lose the chance to resubmit their work
